THE SENATE STANDING ORDERS

SPECIAL SITTING

NOTICE is given to all Senators that pursuant to Standing Order 75 (1) (a) of the Senate Standing Orders, the Speaker of the Senate convened a meeting of the Senate on Tuesday, 16th June, 2020, to hear charges against Hon. Anne Mumbi Waiguru, the Governor of Kirinyaga County;

FURTHER, pursuant to section 33 (3) (b) of the County Governments Act, 2012 and Standing Order 75 (1) (b) (i) of the Senate Standing Orders, on Tuesday, 16th June, 2020, the Senate, by Resolution, appointed a Special Committee comprising eleven of its members to investigate the matter of the proposed removal from office of the Governor of Kirinyaga County and to report to the Senate within ten (10) days of its appointment on whether it finds the particulars of the allegations to have been substantiated:

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to Standing Order 30 (1) of the Senate Standing Orders, on the request of the Senate Majority Leader, with the support of the requisite number of Senators, I have appointed Friday, 26th June, 2020, as a day for a special sitting of the Senate. The sitting shall be held in the Senate Chamber, Main Parliament Buildings, Nairobi, commencing at 2.30 p.m.

The business to be transacted at the sitting shall be the consideration of the Report of the Special Committee on the Proposed Removal from Office, by Impeachment, of Hon. Anne Mumbi Waiguru, the Governor of Kirinyaga County.

In accordance with standing order 30 (5) of the Senate Standing Orders, the business specified in this notice shall be the only business before the Senate during the special sitting, following which the Senate shall stand adjourned until Tuesday, 7th July, 2020, at 2.30 p.m. in accordance with the Senate Calendar.
